9	Relating to pardons and paroles; to provide that an
10	inmate may attend his or her parole hearing by telephone,
11	video conference, or other similar communication system in
12	certain circumstances.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. (a) (1) An inmate shall be allowed to
15	participate in his or her parole hearing via telephone, video
16	conference <mark>,</mark> or <mark>any other similar communications system that</mark>
17	allows the inmate to interact with the members of the Parole
18	Board.
19	(2) Any other individual participating in a parole
20	hearing, including, but not limited to the victim, victim's
21	family, and a crime victim advocate shall also be allowed to
22	participate in a parole hearing via telephone, video
23	conference, or any other similar communications system.
24	(b) The inmate shall not be allowed to see, hear, or
25	otherwise interact with victims, victims' families, or crime
26	victim advocates who address the board or attend the hearing.
27	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
28	1, 2024.
