9	Relating to community development districts; to amend
10	Section $3\frac{5}{6}$ -8B-5, Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for
11	distribution of tax proceeds from alcoholic beverage sales in
12	certain community development districts.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 3 <mark>5</mark> -8B-5, Code of Alabama 1975, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	"§35-8B-5
17	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
18	beginning on October 1, 2021, any proceeds of the sales tax on
19	alcoholic beverages collected by a county in a community
20	development district as provided in Section 35-8B-1(a)(2),
21	(i)(2), and (q)(2), shall be deposited into a special fund in
22	the county treasury to be used for grants to support
23	education, civic, community, and tourism activities within the
24	county in which the taxes were collected.
25	(b) Grants awarded pursuant to subsection (a) shall be
26	distributed based on the recommendation of each legislator
27	representing a portion of the county in which the funds were
28	collected, based on the proportion of the population he or she

- 30 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
- 31 2024.
