

## House Education Policy Reported Substitute for HB308

6	TO BE ENTITLED
7	AN ACT
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9	Relating to alternative teacher certification; to amend
10	Section 16-23-3.1, Code of Alabama 1975, as last amended by
11	Act 2023-451, 2023 Regular Session; to provide that an
12	additional method by which certain alternative teacher
13	examination preparation programs may be approved by the State
14	Board of Education; and to make nonsubstantive, technical
15	revisions to update the existing code language to current
16	style.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Section 16-23-3.1, Code of Alabama 1975, as
19	last amended by Act 2023-451, 2023 Regular Session, is amended
20	to read as follows:
21	"§16-23-3.1
22	(a) The State of Alabama shall modify its policies
23	relative to the certification of teachers to permit the
24	issuance of a professional educator certificate to those
25	qualified individuals who successfully complete an approved
26	alternative teacher preparation program. In addition to any
27	provisional certificates and professional certificates issued
28	pursuant to this chapter to individuals graduating from



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29 approved teacher education programs, the State Board of 30 Education shall authorize the issuance of a professional 31 educator certificate by the State Superintendent of Education 32 to a qualified individual who completes an approved 33 alternative teacher preparation program.

34 (b) The State Superintendent of Education shall 35 maintain a database of alternative teacher education 36 preparation organizations, approved by the State Board of 37 Education, as a means for screening, recruiting, and recommending for certification qualified individuals to teach 38 39 in the public K-12 schools. An approved alternative teacher 40 education preparation organization, at a minimum, shall 41 require each applicant whom the approved organization 42 recommends for initial licensure to satisfy all of the 43 following:

44 (1) Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited
45 institution of higher education which offers, at a minimum,
46 junior and senior level courses of instruction.

47 (2) Successfully pass a criminal history background48 information check.

49 (3) Successfully complete an alternative teacher50 preparation program offered by the approved organization.

(c) (1) Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, in determining which alternative teacher education preparation organizations to approve, the State Board of Education shall consider only the following prerequisites:

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a. Successful operation in at least five states and is



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57 not on probation in any of those states. This requirement does 58 not apply to two-year or four-year institutions of higher 59 education operating in the state with state-approved programs.

b. Successful operation of an alternative teachereducation preparation program for at least 10 years.

c. Requirement that an applicant pass an examination
that is substantively aligned with Alabama standards in
subject area, pedagogy, or both.

d. Evidence of successfully certifying at least 10,000
teachers in the United States. This requirement does not apply
to two-year or four-year institutions of higher education
operating in the state with state-approved programs.

69 (2) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if If an 70 alternative teacher education preparation organization does 71 not satisfy the prerequisites provided in paragraphs (1)a. 72 through (1)d. subdivision (1), the alternative teacher 73 education preparation organization may be approved if the 74 organization is certified by the Council for the Accreditation 75 of <u>Education</u> Educator Preparation or the Association for 76 Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation.

(d) An individual who is granted a professional educator certificate pursuant to this section may teach in the subject areas and at the educational levels he or she has successfully completed through the alternative teacher preparation program offered by the approved alternative teacher education preparation organization.

(e) An individual who holds a professional educatorcertificate pursuant to this section may apply for a



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85 professional renewal license and shall in all other respects 86 be treated in the same manner as an individual who holds a 87 professional educator certificate granted upon successful 88 completion of traditional, in-state teaching certification 89 programs.

90 (f) An approved alternative teacher education 91 preparation organization shall submit a detailed report to the 92 State Board of Education annually detailing the number of 93 individuals who completed the program during that year.

94 (g) Upon receiving an alternative certificate to teach 95 pursuant to this section, the teacher shall participate in the 96 Alabama Teacher Mentorship Program if hired by a local board 97 of education that participates in the program."

98 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 99 1, 2024.
