22	Section 1. (a) Beginning January 1, 2025, each
23	individual elected to serve as mayor or as a member of the
24	governing body of any municipality shall enroll in,
25	participate in, and satisfactorily complete, during each year
26	of their first elected term that commences after January 1,
27	2025, a training course that meets the requirements of
28	subsection (b).



- 29 (b) A training course shall consist of at least 10
- 30 hours and shall include instruction in each of the following
- 31 subjects:
- 32 (1) The general powers of municipalities.
- 33 (2) The duties of mayors and governing bodies of
- 34 municipalities.
- 35 (3) Ethics.
- 36 (4) Annexations.
- 37 (5) The authority to expend municipal funds.

- 40 (8) Legislative advocacy.

- 49 (17) The public purpose doctrine.
- 50 (18) The Open Meetings Act.
- 51 (19) Municipal boards.
- 52 (20) Zoning.
- 53 (21) Any other subject recommended by the Alabama
- 54 League of Municipalities.
- (c) Any individual who has successfully completed the
- 56 Certified Municipal Official Program administered by the



- 57 Alabama League of Municipalities shall be exempt from the

- 59 Section 2. Beginning January 1, 2025, each individual
- 60 elected or appointed to serve as mayor or as a member of the
- 61 governing body of any municipality who has already completed
- the training required by Section 1 shall enroll in,
- 63 participate in, and satisfactorily complete, annually, at
- least five hours of continuing education courses pertaining to
- any of the subjects listed in Section 1.
- Section 3. Any training provided pursuant to this act
- shall be developed in consultation with the Alabama Ethics
- 68 Commission, the Attorney General's Office, and the Department
- of Examiners of Public Accounts.
- 70 Section 4. (a) All expenses incurred by an individual
- 71 related to any training required by this act, including, but
- 72 not limited to, the cost of the training and the reasonable
