Section 2. (a) Related to in vitro fertilization and notwithstanding any provision of law, including any cause of action provided in Chapter 5 of Title 6, Code



25 of Alabama 1975, for the damage to or death of an
26 embryo brought against the manufacturer of goods used
27 to facilitate the in vitro fertilization process or
28 the transport of stored embryos, damages shall be
29 limited to compensatory damages calculated as the
30 price paid for the impacted in vitro cycle.

31 (b) Related to in vitro fertilization and
32 notwithstanding any provision of law, no criminal
33 prosecution may be brought for the damage to or death
34 of an embryo against the manufacturer of goods used to
35 facilitate the in vitro fertilization process or the
36 transport of stored embryos.

37 (c) This section is remedial in nature and is intended
